Description of the Organization: The Monterey County Vintners and Growers Association (MCVGA) is a 501 (c) (6) non-profit corporation serving as the trade organization for Monterey's vintners and winegrape growers. The MCVGA is currently seeking an Executive Director to lead the organization, reporting to the Executive Committee (3 to 5-member committee) and Board of Directors (15 elected members, including the Executive Committee). Job Summary: The Executive Director is responsible for guiding the MCVGA to position the Monterey County wine industry and execute the vision the Board of Directors set forth. They are an enthusiastic leader and a committed consensus builder with demonstrated accomplishments and practical experience in marketing, branding, promotion, public relations, public policy, grants administration, and consensus building. Professional Responsibilities: Develop and execute an annual strategic plan and budget to advance the MCVGA's mission and vision, garnering support from industry stakeholders and key partners. Lead and manage all aspects of the organization's operations, including budgeting, financial management, and human resources. Build and maintain strong relationships with industry stakeholders, including vintners, growers, government agencies, community organizations, and the media, fostering trust and

consensus. Serve as the primary spokesperson and face of the organization, representing MCVGA in media relations, community engagement, and industry forums. Oversee grassroots marketing, branding, and promotion efforts to enhance the visibility and reputation of the Monterey County wine industry.
